**Five-Day Special Training Programme in Competition Law** 

**Thematic Focus** 

The primary objective of competition policy is to enhance consumer welfare by

promoting competition and controlling practices that could restrict it. Competition

laws need to be transparent and their enforcement predictable, and rulings on

competition cases should be both consistent and based on non-discriminatory criteria.

The demonstrated willingness of competition authorities to prevent, correct and

sanction anticompetitive practices can have a significant positive bearing on the

investment climate of the country. A better appreciation of competition policy

perspectives would help when laws and regulations are being developed in order to

highlight possible trade-offs between competition and other policy objectives. The

present course would provide a basic understanding of competition law and the points

to consider while formulating policies.

**Course Objective & Pedagogy** 

The training programme for Judges/Legal Professionals/Government Officials has

been designed to provide a multiple angle refresher in Competition Law. The

University understands that Judges/officials in any part of the world, do understand

and practice these dimensions. But, like every other subject-matter, it is important to

once in a while revisit them to refresh one's viewpoint or even generate new ones.

The University also acknowledges the busy schedule participants have and it would

not be feasible to place an elaborate schedule for the course. Therefore, in just five

days, ten topics have been identified which touch upon the traditional and the

contemporary in the training areas. Participants will surely benefit from the highly

specialized resource persons who will we administering these sessions – from Judges

of Indian Courts to Expert Legal Academics.

The sessions will follow a pedagogy of lecture and discussion, designed to allow an

interactive engagement for better analytical and critical understanding of the topics. It

is with this aim that each session is set for a duration of one and a half hours, with the

last fifteen minutes devoted to questions and answers.
