Brief Course Outline

1. Objective:

The course aims to introduce the participants to the guiding principles and types of voter registration (VR), collection, preparation and purification of voter's data, use of technology in VR, and other processes to avoid electoral fraud. The course also focusses on developing a shared understanding of VR principles and processes through presentations of participating countries.

2. Contents of the course:

Focussing on the question of electoral integrity, the course addresses one the foremost aspects of election management viz. Voter Registration. The sessions cover the various aspects of VR such as the legal framework of VR, types and steps of VR, preparation and periodic purification of electoral roll, processes of data collection and its maintenance, information security vis-à-vis VR, voter education for inclusion in the electoral roll, and use of technology for VR.

3. Learning Outcome:

The participants learn about Voter Registration and its operational intricacies.
