Introduction

The achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) by 2030 will not be possible without a massive push for responsible investments in development projects and sustainable technologies. Increased responsible investments in development projects will not just contribute to economic transformation by creating new job opportunities and generating income but also diversifying production base, improving market access and infrastructure development leading to leading global Sustainable development.

To promote an efficient global utilization of investment resources and to overcome the discrepancy between the demand and supply for investments, capacity building on investment project preparation is critical. The capacity development will not just impart the information about pursuing public funding grants from federal, state, and local agencies and other governmental or quasi-governmental organizations. Rather, this would enable the civil servants to identify the new opportunities in the investment projects and attract the new investors for the same. The capacity building for preparation of responsible investment projects would increase the number of investment transactions and to formulate reliable and sustainable investment proposals. Finally, the Capacity building on investment project preparation is an essential step towards enhancing economic competitiveness and increasing sustainable development in strategic sectors to attract domestic and international investment.

- Challenges in Project Implementation Planning and Appraisal
