TRAINING PROGRAMMES <u>FOR</u> THE OFFICIALS OF THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE OF THE KINGDOM OF CAMBODIA

COURSE CONTENT

The National Judicial Academy has received a proposal from the Ministry of Justice of the Kingdom of Cambodia to organise two separate physical short-term training and Capacity Building programmes. These programmes will focus on the themes of "Good Governance and Implementation of Civil Judgment Decisions" and "Good Governance and Implementation of Criminal justice System" for a group of forty officials of the Ministry of Justice of the Kingdom of Cambodia.

The programs will encompass sessions focused on "Good Governance and Implementation of Civil Judgment Decisions" covering topics such as Recognizing and Practicing a Foreign Civil Judgment in the roles of Bailiff and Court Clerk, as well as the Efficiency of Handling Civil Matters in these roles. Additionally, they will address the Implementation Process for Accessing Movable and Immovable Assets. Under the theme of "Good Governance and Implementation of the Criminal Justice System," the program will delve into the Effectiveness of Administering Criminal Cases, particularly in terms of executing the Court's Decisions or Judgments. The programme will facilitate discussions on Court & Case management and integration of ICT in Judicial process in administration of justice.
