TRAINING PROGRAM ON GENDER-VIOLENCE FOR MAGISTRATES AND JUDICIAL STAFF OF PERU

COURSE CONTENT

The National Judicial Academy India, Bhopal is organizing this program which aims to foster an exchange of experiences to enhance the quality of judicial services. The primary goal of this exchange is to establish connections for mutual collaboration, with the overarching objective of improving the delivery of justice.

The program will encompass various sessions, including- Exploring Gender Perspectives: Origins, Dynamics, and Modalities; Implementing International Standards for Combating Gender Violence; Transition toward a Gender-Equitable Society: A Fundamental Shift; Judicial Approaches to Compensatory Jurisprudence in Cases of Gender Violence and Fostering Gender Sensitivity in the Justice Delivery System. The transition of the Indian Judiciary towards a more gender-equitable society will be highlighted. Additionally, the programme will cover topics such as "Understanding Gender Violence: A Psycho-Social Approach" and "Cultivating an Appropriate Judicial Persona in Adjudicating Cases of Gender Violence." The courses is designed to promote a deeper understanding of gender-related issues and improve the handling of gender violence cases within the judicial system.
