

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOMB DISPOSAL (ADVANCE) COURSE (FOREIGN TRAINEES)

Aim

1. The aim of this course is to train personnel, who can subsequently impart training in search, detection, recognition and rendering safe disposal of IEDs in their organisation. The course builds on knowledge gained in BD Basic Course. NSG Training Academy conducts BD Advance course once a year.

Training Aspects

2. **Course Duration.** 04 weeks.

3. **Pre-Course Training.** All trainees should have undergone a minimum of two weeks pre-course training and should be conversant with service explosives.

4. **Work Schedule.** There will be six working days in a week and nine periods of 40 minutes duration daily.

5. **Requirement.** The trainees should fulfill these qualitative requirement (QRs) to attend this course :-

(a) **Service.** Minimum service of three years

(b) **Age.** Below 45 yr.

(c) **Education Qualification.** High school graduate or above, preferably with science subjects and having basic knowledge of English/ Hindi.

(d) **Medical & Physical.** Should be medically and physically fit in all respect.

(e) **Discipline.** The trainees should be of high discipline/ character.

(f) Should be a volunteer.

6. **Screening Test.** An initial screening test will be conducted on **first day of first week** to judge the skills of each trainee. Subsequent to qualifying in screening test, candidates will undergo the course. Those failing in the screening test will be returned to unit.

7. **Methodology of Training.** The training will be basic in nature, wherein emphasis will be on detection and disposal of IEDs. The training will be mostly practical in nature.

8. **Conduct of Classes.** Training will be imparted both by lectures and demonstrations. Classes will be conducted as per a structured and approved training program. Trainees will be provided with a detailed course syllabus upon their arrival at the NSG Training Academy.

10. **Grading System.** All foreign trainees will be awarded with 'Qualified' grading.

Administrative Aspects

11. **Documentation.** All trainee will carry the following :-

- (a) Passport
- (b) I-Card (Authority letter from the organisation if submitted before travel)
- (c) Medical fitness certificate signed by Medical Officer
- (d) Willingness certificate
- (e) Movement order
- (f) Ten passport size photographs in uniform
- (g) Pre-Course certificate duly signed by Officer Commanding Unit.

12. **Clothing.** Details of the clothing and equipment required to be brought by each trainee is given below :-

- (a) Uniform Set - Two pairs/ winter/ summer.
(Depending on the weather).
- (b) Cape Water Proof - One (During monsoon season).
- (c) PT Shoes - One pair.
- (d) Socks for PT - Five pair.
- (e) Boot Ankle/ DMS - One pair.
- (f) Jungle Boot - One pair.
- (g) Cap Field Service and Beret - One each.
- (h) **Private Clothing.** Each trainee should carry sufficient private clothing according to prevalent weather conditions as per para 15.

13. **Visit.** During the course, the trainees will be taken to Delhi/ Agra for the visit.

14. **Leave.** No leave will be granted during the course except on compassionate grounds and correspondence by the embassy.
