

Day	Tentative Training Schedule
I st Week	
Day-1	Enrolment / Registration and Inauguration. Introduction to IRIDM rules & regulations, DM Plan and Crisis Management, Briefing about scenarios and IRIDM Recce.
Day-2	Introduction and discussion about ART, ARME/SPART and DM Equipment in Railways, Introduction to Rolling stocks and Discussion on its critical areas w.r.t. accident, emergency provisions in AC, Non-AC coaches, Train set etc.
Day-3	Types of accidents/disasters, Railway Accident, its Classification, Role & responsibilities of onboard staff during golden hour at accident site. Scenario -1 Practical Training for rescue from accidental Rolling Stock, especially from Passenger Coaches in tunnel accident.
Day-4	Classification of Fire, fire accidents, types of fire extinguishers & Firefighting methods using each type of fire extinguisher. (minor & Major) Practical demonstration on firefighting using various types of Fire Extinguishers
Day-5	Visit to SPART and ARME for On-site Hands on Experience in ART/ARME and Vande Bharat and different IR Rolling Stock.
Day-6	Study tour (Mysuru Visit – To familiarise the Participants with Indian Heritage, Culture, History including visit to Rail Museum(Rail Heritage).
Day-7	Week Off

Day-8	Discussion of cutting tools for extrication & rescue of injured passengers and different types of cutting tools & equipment. Scenario – 2 Rope Rescue of injured passengers. Extricating the injured from the coach roof and taking it to the top of the tunnel. Rope Rescue of injured passengers in the cutting area during a railway accident.
Day-9	Case Studies on International Railway Accidents. Scenario – 3 Practical Training for rescue from accidental Rolling Stock, especially from Passenger Coaches in climbed and an entangled coach in railway accident. Scenario – 4 Practical Training for rescue from accidental Rolling Stock especially from Passenger Coaches in capsized condition.
Day-10	Scenario – 5 Practicing session on Firefighting and Back & Neck Injuries activities using AR/VR mode.
Day-11	Pycho Social Support in Disaster Management, Disaster Sites Communication Scenario – 6 Water Body Rescue and Practicing session on Rescue of injured passengers from the coach fallen from the bridge in water.
Day-12	Evaluation / Assessment, Debriefing session, Feed Back, Valedictory and relieving.
